The J. Richard Hill “Man of the Year” award becomes one of the most coveted of the annual awards presented to the membership. A Nominee for the J. Richard Hill “Man of the Year” award may be any individual in good standing with CARSES as of February 1st of the calendar year in which the nominee is submitted, and who has made an outstanding contribution for and through CARSES for the betterment of the HVACR industry and/or community. CARSES elected officers, international officers and directors are not eligible.

RULES GOVERNING THE SELECTION

1. Any CARSES member in good standing as of February first of the calendar year in which the nomination is submitted who has made an outstanding contribution during the past five years, as listed under eligibility requirements, is eligible for the J. Richard Hill “Man of the Year” award.
2. Applications must be in the hands of judges by March first.
3. Applications and/or entries for the award of the member to be recognized shall be mailed to the CARSES president. He, in turn, shall forward all entries to the judges for final selection of a winner for the award.
4. The judges shall be the president of CARSES and two elected officers that have been appointed by the president. Award committee decisions are final.
5. The award will be announced and presented during the CARSES annual education conference to the winner in person, absentia, or posthumously.

An absentia award may be made to another member of the winners’ chapter if they are in attendance, to a delegate or alternate representing the winners’ chapter, or to the officer or director in the winner’s area.

Certainly your chapter has one member eligible for this award. Now is the time to submit nominations for those you feel have earned this distinguished award.

The entry shall spell out in detail what was accomplished and how the accomplishment was achieved. It may be accompanied by documentation such as newspaper clippings, letters, photo's, or other materials strengthening the nomination in the following areas...

1. Furthering safety practices
2. Contributing toward the use of education in the field of refrigeration and air conditioning
3. Working toward favorably publicizing and promoting CARSES, its goals, and activities
4. Efforts towards recruiting CARSES members and increasing membership
5. Contributions toward the general welfare of chapters, regional associations, or RSES International
